Tecnikabel, in respect of other strategic business objectives and of the needs and development programs, taking into account the availability of resources and technological progress, is committed to continuously improve the framework of its environmental performance through the setting of annual objectives and programs aimed at continuous improvement.

The Policy applies to all production processes of Volpiano plant, including: extrusion, stranding, braiding.

Tecnikabel is committed to communicate its policy to employees, businesses, employees and suppliers of the company and make it operational by applying the following principles:
